NCBA Division III World Series Moves to Johnstown, PA

Pittsburgh, PA -- The National Club Baseball Association is thrilled to announce that the Division III World Series sponsored by Rawlings™ will be taking place at Sargent's Stadium at the Point in Johnstown, Pennsylvania. The four DIII district champions will battle it out for the national title in a double elimination tournament May 17th-19th, 2019. The NCBA Division II New Penn Regional tournament will also be held there May 3rd-5th.



Sargent's Stadium, built in 1926, is a historic landmark where many hall of famers have played. It has been heavily renovated over the years. This spring, it will feature a fully turfed field with the exception of the pitcher's mound. It features a seating capacity of approximately 7,500, lights, a scoreboard, a press box, and is situated right inside the fork of the Conemaugh River. The dimensions of the playing field are unique. It is 290 feet down the left-field line, 336 feet in left-center, 409 feet in dead center, 395 feet in right-center, and 290 down the right field line. The layout is similar that of Fenway Park, home of the Boston Red Sox.

"The Johnstown community is very excited that the NCBA will be bringing two great events to our town in May," says Nicole Waligora of Visit Johnstown. "Johnstown has a rich baseball history, and this will be another chapter in our book! I am certain that these athletes will have a great experience, and will leave our town with wonderful memories."

"It should be a great atmosphere for all in attendance. They will get to see competitive baseball and see just what club sports are all about. These players simply play for the love of the game," says Garrett Siemek, NCBA Director of DIII Baseball Operations.
