2020 NCBA DIII World Series Returning to Johnstown, PA

Pittsburgh, PA -- The National Club Baseball Association is excited to announce that the Division III World Series sponsored by Rawlings™ will be once again be taking place at Sargent's Stadium at the Point in Johnstown, Pennsylvania. The four DIII district champions will battle it out for the national title in a double elimination tournament from May 15th-17th, 2020.



Sargent's Stadium, built in 1926, is a historic landmark in the baseball community. Situated right inside the fork of the Conemaugh River, it features a fully turfed field with the exception of the pitcher's mound, a seating capacity of approximately 7,500, lights, a scoreboard, a press box, and is currently home to the AAABA Baseball Hall of Fame and the University of Pittsburgh – Johnstown Mountain Cats Baseball. The stadium has also hosted numerous minor league baseball teams as well as large events such as Presidential campaign rallies and Pittsburgh Steelers practices.
